ONE PAGER

This *One Pager* is a single-page response that shows your understanding of Japanese Middle Ages/Feudalism. It is a way of making representation of your individual, unique understanding. It is a way to be creative and experimental; it is a way to respond to your reading imaginatively and honestly.

The purpose of a One Pager is to own what you are reading since we read differently when we know we are going to do something with the text that we have read. We learn best when we are able to create our own patterns!

Directions:

1. Pull out two (2) quotations from the chapter and write them on your page. Please also write the page number where each quote can be found in the text or the title of the document where you got the quote from. Follow each quotation with a short explanation of why the quote is important, interesting, etc. Use these quotes as a springboard to explore your own ideas about the reading.
2. Use two (2) visual images that you have drawn to create a central focus for your pages. For each visual write a short caption describing the image and its significance. Please try to avoid using portraits. However, if you feel the need to use a portrait, include other visuals in addition to the portrait.
3. Identify and state the historical significance of two individuals / groups / issues.
4. Make a personal summary statement or reflection statement about what you have read in the chapter. In other words, discuss what you think about the chapter topic or theme. (What have I learned? New Insights? Agree or Disagree with X person's Point of View?)

Feel free to use colored pens, pencils, crayons markers, etc. The more visually appealing, the better.
